ORDER SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On July 25, 1997, October 23, 1997, and November 4, 1997, efforts were made to schedule this matter for prehearing conference by Cynthia Castañeda, Legal Technician. Because repeated telephonic efforts to schedule this prehearing conference have been unavailing, a telephonic case management conference is hereby scheduled for Wednesday, December 17, 1997 at 2:00 p.m. (CST). The parties or representatives should be prepared and authorized to address the following issues:

1. whether all parties have correctly designated and properly served;
2. whether there are any jurisdictional disputes;
3. whether there have been any settlement discussions and, if so, the status of settlement discussions;
4. whether any amendments to the pleadings are contemplated;
5. each party's discovery plan and the time reasonably required to complete discovery;
and
6. whether the party intends to file any dispositive motions.

Complainant indicated that he is represented by counsel; however, no notice of appearance has been received. Complainant is advised to instruct his attorney to file a notice of appearance as required by applicable rules.¹

¹ Rules of Practice and Procedure for Administrative Hearings, 28 C.F.R. Pt. 68 (1996). Rule 68.33(b)(5) requires that the attorney certify that such notice was served on all parties of record.

Any party wishing a change in the date or time of the prehearing conference shall contact the opposing party and obtain that party's agreement to an alternative date and time before requesting a change in the schedule.
