ORDER SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE
(February 23, 1998)

Although filings pursuant to my Order issued January 12, 1998 suggest progress toward settlement, the failure to conclude negotiations makes clear the need for judicial intervention. Accordingly, this Order confirms that a prehearing conference in this proceeding will be conducted by telephone on March 3, 1998, at 2:00 p.m., EST, as previously advised and arranged by the Judge's staff. The conference will be initiated by my Office.

1. Prior to the conference, the parties will be expected to develop stipulations of facts and agree as to procedural matters. At the conference, they shall report on their efforts.
2. The prehearing conference will focus primarily on the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing. The parties should be prepared to discuss trial preparation in the context of the rules of practice and procedure of this Office, 28 C.F.R. Part 68, particularly those sections governing prehearing statements and prehearing conferences, i.e., § 68.12(b).
3. An original and two copies of all pleadings shall be filed with my office.
4. The parties should not provide copies to the Judge of either discovery requests or responses. If, however, a request for relief is filed, it should be accompanied by the underlying requests or responses. I will not entertain any discovery motion unless:

A) I direct otherwise or

B) the motion is accompanied by a certification that the moving party has conferred, or has made a reasonable effort to confer, with the opposing party concerning the matter.
