
**ORDER GRANTING UNITED STATES' MOTION FOR REDUCTION OF
SENTENCE PURSUANT TO FED. R. CRIM. PRO.35**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the United States' Motion for Reduction of Sentence Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. Pro.35 (**DE#49**), filed April 4, 2012 as a result of his substantial assistance to law enforcement. The Court held a hearing, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the United States' Motion for Reduction of Sentence Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. Pro. 35 (D.E.#49), is **Granted**.

1. **Jean Fourcand** shall be committed to the Bureau of Prisons for a total term of **Two (2) months**, followed by 2 years, supervised release.
2. The Defendant shall surrender to the designated facility by the Bureau of Prisons, or at the Atkins Building, 2nd Floor, at 301 N. Miami Ave, Miami, Florida on **Monday, April 30, 2012 on or before 2:00 p.m.**
3. All other terms and conditions of the Judgment in a Criminal case dated May 3, 2010 shall remain in full force and effect.
