



In his application, **TURNAGE** falsely claimed that on August 29, 2005, the day Katrina struck, his primary residence was 34 Keane Drive, Chalmette, Louisiana. In fact, **TURNAGE** resided in Ponchatoula, Louisiana, a property that was ineligible for disaster assistance.

Due to the material false statements concerning residency contained in his LRHP application, **TURNAGE** received \$89,355.46 in federal disaster assistance to which he was not entitled. **TURNAGE** made the material false statements to LRHP knowing the statements were false, and for the purpose of misleading LRHP.

After being advised of his constitutional rights, **TURNAGE** admitted the foregoing facts to agents of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of the Inspector General.
