The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about the 28th day of February, 2007, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BRANDON BANKS**, did knowingly and by means and use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm, forcibly assault, resist, oppose, impede, intimidate, and interfere with Karen
