The United States Attorney charges that:

COUNT 1 - POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

Beginning at a time unknown and continuing until on or about October 30, 2009, within the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, the defendant, **MICHAEL T. DRURY**, did knowingly possess one or more matters, that is, computer hard drives and computer media, containing digital images, computer images, and digital video files, that contained visual depictions that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and that were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and such visual depictions were of such conduct.


All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE


1. The allegations of this Indictment are re-alleged as if fully set forth herein, for the purpose of alleging forfeiture, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.

2. If convicted of the offense or offenses set forth above, the defendant, **MICHAEL T. DRURY**, shall forfeit to the United States any and all materials and property used and intended to be used in the receipt and possession of visual depictions of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct, as well as any and all property, either real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtains from the offense. Such property includes, but is not limited to, the following specific items found by federal agents on or about October 30, 2009:
 - a. One (1) Gateway MFATXSTL EL2 500S computer, with serial number 0026507432;
 - b. One (1) Sony Vaio laptop computer, with serial number #LPFU3V;
 - c. One (1) Lenovo laptop computer, black, with serial number L3-B0503;
 - d. One (1) Seagate FreeAgent Go 160 GB external hard drive, with serial number 5MABS5Z0;


- e. One (1) Lexar 256MB “thumb” drive;
- f. One (1) SanDisk Cruzer 512MB “thumb” drive; and
- g. One (1) Memorex Traveldrive 2GB “thumb” drive.
