OKLAHOMA MAN SENTENCED ON FIREARMS CHARGES

Gulfport, Miss - Travis Earl Seat, 25, of Oklahoma City, OK, was sentenced in U.S. District Court today to serve 64 months in prison followed by three years of supervised release for possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, U.S. Attorney John Dowdy announced. Seat pled guilty to the charge on August 1, 2011. He has been in federal custody since his arrest on May 6, 2011.

The case was investigated by the Biloxi Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Annette Williams.
