
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

did, in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, and on any land and building owned by, leased to, and otherwise used by and under the control of the United States Government, knowingly possess, and knowingly access with intent to view, any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, computer disk, and other material that contained at least three images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8) (A),

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a) (5) (A) .
