**INFORMATION**

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

**COUNT ONE**

In or about 2005 to 2006, in Upper Deerfield, in the District of New Jersey, in Gallatin, New York, and elsewhere, the defendant,

**CARL TIMM,**

did travel from New Jersey to New York with the purpose to engage in illicit sexual conduct with M.B., a person who had not then attained the age of 12 years.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(b) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2423(e).

**COUNT TWO**

On or about January 29, 2010, in Upper Deerfield, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

**CARL TIMM,**

did knowingly distribute more than ten graphic images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8), each of which had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(2)(A) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**FORFEITURE ALLEGATION**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count One and Count Two of this Information, defendant Carl Timm shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253, all visual depictions which were produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation of the law; all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offense; and the following personal property used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of the offense which was seized by law enforcement officers on or about February 25, 2010 and March 1, 2010 from Carl Timm's residence at 21 Dawson Drive, Upper Deerfield, New Jersey:
