INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States

Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

- 1. At all times relevant to this Information, defendant Brian Walters was an officer in the Public Health Service assigned as the Chief Pharmacist at the Federal Correctional Institution at Fairton (hereinafter "FCI Fairton"). FCI Fairton is a federal correctional facility under the United States Bureau of Prisons (hereinafter "Bureau of Prisons") located in Fairton, Cumberland County, New Jersey.
- 2. As the Chief Pharmacist at FCI Fairton, defendant Brian Walters' duties included, but were not limited to:
 - a. Dispensing prescribed controlled substances and over-the-counter medications to inmates housed at FCI Fairton;
 - b. Ordering pharmaceuticals and other supplies to ensure that the pharmacy at
 FCI Fairton was sufficiently stocked to service the needs of the inmates at FCI Fairton;
 and
 - c. Maintaining sufficient controls over the inventory of supplies at the pharmacy, including the inventory of controlled substances and other medications, to prevent theft and abuse.

- 3. Between in or about July 2008 and on or about October 20, 2009, defendant Brian Walters stole from the pharmacy at FCI Fairton approximately 4,604.5 ml of Nalbuphine Hydrochloride, an opiate-based pain reliever, which he had ordered through his position as the Chief Pharmacist and which had been paid for by the Bureau of Prisons.
- 4. Between in or about July 2008, and on or about October 20, 2009, at Fairton, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

did knowingly and willfully embezzle, steal, purloin and convert to his own use property and things of value of the United States and a department and agency thereof, that is, approximately 4,604.5 ml of Nalbuphine Hydrochloride having an approximate value of \$7,041.44.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 641, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
