STATEMENT ON U.S. v. DAVID STOCKMAN, ET AL.

"After a renewed assessment of the evidence in <u>United</u> <u>States v. David A. Stockman, J. Michael Stepp, David R. Cosgrove,</u> <u>and Paul C. Barnaba</u>, 07 Cr. 220 (BSJ), including evidence and information obtained after the filing of the Indictment, the Government has concluded that further prosecution of this case would not be in the interests of justice. Accordingly, today we submitted a proposed Order of *nolle prosequi* as to each defendant in the above captioned case.

The Order has been approved by the presiding United States District Judge, and thus the prosecution of the case has ended," stated LEV L. DASSIN, Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York.
