**FORMER SCARSDALE HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER SENTENCED TO 51 MONTHS
IN FEDERAL PRISON FOR POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

MICHAEL J. GARCIA, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced that ALLEN JULIER, a former teacher at Scarsdale High School, was sentenced to 51 months in prison today for possession of child pornography.

The sentence was imposed by United States District Judge KENNETH M. KARAS in White Plains federal court. JULIER pleaded guilty on February 1, 2008, to possessing in excess of 100 images and 10 video files containing child pornography on his home computer in Carmel, New York.

Mr. GARCIA praised the efforts of Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the New York State Police, and the Carmel Police Department in connection with this investigation.

Assistant United States Attorney ANNA M. SKOTKO is in charge of the prosecution.
