INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 4, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

**JAMES HAWKINS,
a/k/a “Khalil Bryant,”**

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce approximately fourteen live rounds of ammunition, that is, seven rounds of Remington 9mm Luger ammunition, six rounds of Federal Cartridge Company 9mm Luger ammunition, and one round of Speer 9mm Luger ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1) set forth in this indictment, defendant

**JAMES HAWKINS,
a/k/a “Khalil Bryant,”**

shall forfeit to the United States of America, the magazine and ammunition involved in the commission of such offense including, but not limited to seven rounds of Remington 9mm Luger ammunition, six rounds of Federal Cartridge Company 9mm Luger ammunition, and one round of Speer 9mm Luger ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
