SUN PRAIRIE MAN SENTENCED FOR ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF FIREARM

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Raymond M. Davis, Sr., 52, of Sun Prairie, Wis., was sentenced yesterday by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to two years in prison, without the possibility of parole, for unlawfully possessing a loaded firearm as a convicted felon.

On May 6, 2009, Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force officers executed a warrant at Davis' home after a confidential informant had purchased heroin from a resident of Davis' home. During the search, officers found a loaded handgun, a small amount of heroin, and evidence of drug distribution. Davis admitted the gun was his and the state crime lab identified Davis' DNA on the firearm.

In 1993, Davis was convicted of conspiring to distribute heroin in the Northern District of Indiana. Davis completed his federal supervision in 2005.

The charge against Davis was the result of an investigation conducted by the Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita M. Rumbelow.
