Triadelphia Resident Indicted by Federal Grand Jury on Firearms Charge

WHEELING, WEST VIRGINIA — A Federal Grand Jury sitting in Wheeling, West Virginia, on June 5, 2012, returned a one-count Indictment against RANDAL A. HOWARD.

United States Attorney William J. Ihlenfeld, II, announced that:

RANDAL A. HOWARD, age 41, of Triadelphia, West Virginia, was named in a one-count Indictment charging him with "Felon in Possession of a Firearm." The indictment alleges that HOWARD possessed a firearm on February 28, 2012, despite having a prior felony conviction from the Circuit Court of Ohio County, West Virginia, for Grand Larceny.

"We want encourage state and local law enforcement agencies to continue referring firearms cases to our office so that we may consider them for federal prosecution," said Ihlenfeld.

If convicted, HOWARD faces a maximum exposure of 10 years imprisonment and a fine of \$250,000.

This case will be prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Robert H. McWilliams, Jr. and was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

It should be noted that the charges contained in the above-referenced Indictment are merely accusations and not evidence of guilt, and that the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
