Michigan Resident Sentenced in Federal Court

WHEELING, WEST VIRGINIA — A 26 year old Belleville, Maryland, resident was sentenced on June 28, 2012, in United States District Court in Wheeling by Judge Frederick P. Stamp, Jr.

United States Attorney William J. Ihlenfeld, II, announced that: DEVIN M. SIMMONS was sentenced to 6 months imprisonment to be followed by 2 years of supervised release, with the first 6 months of his release to be served under home detention. SIMMONS entered a plea of guilty on November 16, 2011, to "Possessing 15 or More Counterfeit or Unauthorized Devices with the Intent to Defraud" on September 21, 2011, in Wheeling. SIMMONS, who is free on bond, will self-report to the designated Federal institution on August 28, 2012.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Robert H. McWilliams, Jr. and investigated by the Mountaineer Highway Interdiction Team, which is comprised of the Wheeling Police Department, Ohio County Sheriff's Department, the West Virginia State Police, the Drug Enforcement Administration, and the U.S. Attorney's Office.
