Three Additional Potomac Highlands Individuals Enter Pleas to Methamphetamine Charge

ELKINS, WEST VIRGINIA - Three individuals entered pleas of guilty on June 1, 2012, in United States District Court in Elkins before Magistrate Judge John S. Kaull.

United States Attorney William J. Ihlenfeld, II, announced that:

GARRETT S. SITES, age 28, of Petersburg, West Virginia, entered a plea of guilty to Possession of Pseudoephedrine to be Used in the Manufacture of Methamphetamine on January 19, 2012, In Hardy County, West Virginia. SITES, who is free on bond pending sentencing, faces a maximum exposure of 20 years imprisonment and a fine of \$250,000

KAYLA A. EVANS, age 22, of Petersburg, entered a plea of guilty to Possession of Pseudoephedrine to be Used in the Manufacture of Methamphetamine on September 26, 2011, in Mineral County, West Virginia. EVANS, who is free on bond pending sentencing, faces a maximum exposure of 20 years imprisonment and a fine of \$250,000

RONI N. NICELY, age 21, of Cabins, West Virginia, entered a plea of guilty to Possession of Material Used in the Manufacture of Methamphetamine on January 27, 2012, in Grant County, West Virginia. NICELY, who is free on bond pending sentencing, faces a maximum exposure of 10 years imprisonment and a fine of \$250,000.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Stephen D. Warner and was investigated by the Grant County Sheriff's Department, the Hardy County Sheriff's Department, the Monongahela National Forest/Law Enforcement and Investigations and the West Virginia State Police.
