Federal Inmate Enters Plea and is Sentenced in Federal Court

CLARKSBURG, WEST VIRGINIA — An FCI Gilmer inmate entered a plea of guilty and was sentenced on May 22, 2012, in United States District Court in Clarksburg before Judge Irene M. Keeley.

United States Attorney William J. Ihlenfeld, II, announced that: EUGENE HUNT, age 40, entered a plea of guilty to one count of possession marijuana on November 12, 2011, at FCI Gilmer. HUNT was sentenced to 4 months imprisonment to be served consecutively with his current 180-month sentence.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Brandon S. Flower and were investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Special Investigative Services at FCI Gilmer.
