I N F O R M A T I O N

The United States Attorney Charges:

(Aiding and abetting another to acquire or obtain controlled substances by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception and subterfuge)

1. At all relevant times:
 - a. Defendant ANITA DAWSON was an osteopathic physician licensed to practice medicine in West Virginia; and,
 - b. Defendant ANITA DAWSON was registered with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 823, and, as such, was authorized to prescribe, administer and dispense controlled substances for legitimate medical purposes in the usual course of professional medical practice.


2. From at least July 2006, through May 2009, at or near Milton, Cabell County, West Virginia, within the Southern District of West Virginia, and elsewhere, defendant ANITA DAWSON aided and abetted a person known to the United States Attorney to knowingly and intentionally acquire and obtain controlled substances by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception and subterfuge.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 843(a)(3) and Title 18 United States Code, Section 2.
