entered by the Court at any time after the expiration of
thirty (30) days following the date of filing of this
Stipulation without any further notice to any party or upon
the Court's own motion, provided that plaintiff has not
withdrawn its consent as hereinafter provided;

(2) The plaintiff may withdraw its consent hereto at
any time within said period of thirty (30) days by serving
notice thereof upon the other party hereto and filing
said notice with the Court;

(3) In the event plaintiff withdraws its consent hereto,
neither this proceeding nor the making of this Stipulation

nor the filing of the attached Proposed Final Judgment shall in any manner prejudice any consenting party in any subsequent proceedings.
