Telesca, at the United States Courthouse, 100 State Street, Rochester, New York, for an Order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56 granting plaintiff summary judgment and entering judgment on the Complaint on the grounds that: (1) the Individual Service Agreement entered into between defendant Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation and the University of Rochester, dated and effective March 31, 1994, is a restraint of trade in violation of Section 1 of the Sherman Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1; and (2) the conduct of defendant Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation is not immune under the state action doctrine.
