COUNT 1

[Introducing Adulterated Food into Interstate Commerce]

From in or around July 2014, through and including on or about March 4, 2017, in Delaware County in the Northern District of New York, and elsewhere, the defendant, **VULTO CREAMERY, LLC**, did cause the introduction of food into interstate commerce, namely cheese produced at Vulto Creamery that was adulterated because it was prepared, packed, and held under insanitary conditions whereby it may have been rendered injurious to health under Title 21, United States Code, Section 342(a)(4), and in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 331(a) and 333(a)(1).


