The Grand Jury charges:

On or about between January 1, 2017, and April 9, 2019, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Sheila White, being an officer and employee of the United States Postal Service, did embezzle a letter, postal card, package, bag, and mail and anything contained therein, which was entrusted to her and which came into her possession, and which was intended to be conveyed by mail and carried and delivered by a carrier, messenger, agent, and other person employed by the United States Postal Service; and did steal, abstract, and remove from any such letter, package, bag, and mail, any article or thing contained therein, namely: prescription medications and other items of value that had been placed in the custody and control of the United States Postal Service and intended to be conveyed by mail, with the intent to convert them to her own use, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1709.
