Proceedings: CHANGE OF PLEA

- X The Court Further Orders position papers with respect to sentencing shall be filed not later than two weeks prior to the date of sentencing. Any replies shall be filed no later than one week prior to sentencing.
- X Other The Court orders the defendant remains on bond under the same terms and conditions previously set. The Court Orders the status conference and Trial Date vacated as to this defendant only.
