On May 29, 2013, the City of New Orleans ("City") petitioned¹ the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit ("Fifth Circuit") for an emergency stay of the above-captioned matter pending the City's appeal of the Court's January 11, 2013 order approving the Consent Decree. The United States of America opposes the City's petition.

The Fifth Circuit temporarily stayed all proceedings in this matter until further notice.² Accordingly, the Consent Decree Court Monitor Selection Committee's ("Committee") May 31, 2013 meeting is **CANCELED** and the attendant briefing schedule regarding the Monitor is **VACATED**. The Court will issue a separate notice to the public that the Committee meeting has been canceled.³

In addition, the Parties shall publish a copy of (1) this minute entry (without attachments) and (2) the Court's notice on their respective websites no later than **Friday**, **May 31, 2013, at 9:00 a.m.**

The Court will issue further orders, as appropriate, upon receipt of the Fifth Circuit's forthcoming ruling on the City's petition for an emergency stay.
