
hello Joan,

At the Android Leads meeting today, it was recommended by Patrick Brady and Nikhil that the following language be removed from the MADA: "Unless Google otherwise approves in writing, Company will set Google Search as the default search provider when requests are made to the system search intents, including "assist", "search", "voice search", and "Web search" intents".

Sundar was supportive and confirmed he would discuss with L-team next Monday. His other feedback was that i) we should not pro-actively amend existing MADA's; adjusting language at renewal is fine, and ii) he'd like to soften the MADA to make it more gentle. We also discussed that the OEM search revenue share deals is a good place to re-insert this kind of language/commitment.
