subject to the laws of the United States relating to Indian affairs and Yurok Telecommunications
Corporation is a corporation, association, or group which is organized under any of such laws.

(18 U.S.C. § 666(a)(1)(A) – Theft or Bribery Concerning Programs Receiving

Beginning in or about July 2021, and continuing to in or about May 2022, in the Northern District of California, the defendant,

JESSICA ENGLE,

being the Chief Executive officer of Yurok Telecommunications Corporation and thus an agent of an Indian tribal government and an agency of an Indian tribal government, specifically the Yurok Telecommunications Corporation, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Yurok Tribe, an Indian Tribal government subject to the laws of the United States relating to Indian affairs, said government and agency receiving in the one year period beginning September 1, 2021, benefits in excess of \$10,000 from Federal agencies such as the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Department of Agriculture, embezzled, stole, obtained by fraud, without authority knowingly converted to the use of a person not the rightful owner, and intentionally misapplied property worth at least \$5,000 and owned by, under the care of, under the custody of, and under the control of such government and agency, that is, approximately \$579,574, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 666(a)(1)(A).
