GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED: Page 1 of 2

On October 20, 2006, the District of Columbia Office of Inspector General Medicaid Fraud Control Unit received an Unusual Incident Report (UIR). The UIR states that George Brown (C1) was physically abused by his caregiver, Vera Uchenna Egwin (S1) on October 14, 2006. C1 resides at a group home managed by Resources for Human Development (RHD) located at 615 55th Street, SE, Washington, D.C. S1 was employed by RHD as a Quality Support Associate assigned to provide care at C1's group home. C1 is a 71-year old male who is diagnosed with several conditions that substantially impair him from adequately providing for his own care. Pursuant to D.C. Code § 22-932, C1 is a vulnerable adult.

Affiant interviewed C1 on November 2, 2006. C1 stated that on October 14, 2006, S1 entered into his bedroom at the group home while he was watching television. C1 stated that he told S1 to leave his room. C1 stated that S1 refused to leave and she hit him in the face with an open hand causing an injury to his left side of his face next to his ear.

Affiant interviewed the Quality Mental Retardation Professional (W1) assigned to C1's group home on November 2, 2006. W1 stated that on October 16, 2006, C1 approached her and said that S1 had hit him. C1 showed W1 a scratch on the left side of his face next to his ear. W1 stated that she immediately reported the abuse to her supervisors. C1 was examined by a registered nurse (W2) who works for RDH on October 17, 2006.

Affiant interviewed W2 on November 9, 2006, by telephone. W2 confirmed that she examined C1 on October 17, 2006, and found a two centimeter skin tear on the left side of C1's face, next to his ear. W2 stated that C1's injury was consistent with an injury caused by a ring on someone's hand. W2 stated that C1 told her that he was assaulted by S1.

On November 2, 2006, Affiant interviewed S1, who denied entering C1's room or hitting him on October 14, 2006. S1 stated that she was working with another client. Affiant told S1 that the group home's logs show that she did the resident's laundry on October 14, 2006. S1 then stated she remembered going into the C1's room to put away some clothes.

On December 7, 2006, C1 was shown a Maryland Department of Motor Administration photo of S1. C1 confirmed that the individual depicted in the photograph is the person who assaulted him.

Based upon evidentiary information obtained during the investigation, Affiant believes S1 committed the crime of Criminal Abuse of a Vulnerable Adult as defined in D.C. Code § 22-933 when she hit C1 on the left side of his face with an open hand and caused an injury to his face. Based on the above mentioned facts and circumstances, Affiant believes that probable cause exists for a District of Columbia Superior Court Judge to issue a warrant for the arrest of Vera Uchenna Egwin.
