EOIR to Stop Holding Hearings in Pittsburgh on Sidney Street

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) today announced that it will no longer be holding hearings in Pittsburgh, effective at the close of business on April 29, 2022. Due to space and personnel limitations, the Department of Homeland Security is unable to continue to support immigration court hearings at the location on Sidney Street at this time.

EOIR is committed to continuing to serve Pittsburgh-area respondents and their representatives through the Philadelphia Immigration Court’s operations. Parties with cases assigned to the Pittsburgh hearing location will have the option to have their cases heard in-person at the Philadelphia Immigration Court, or remotely from their homes or offices. All parties will be notified of their options in advance of their scheduled hearing dates.
