We are pleased to invite you to government-to-government consultations with the Department of Justice (DOJ) to discuss implementation of the Alaska Pilot Program established in the Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization Act of 2022 for the designation of participating Alaska Tribes to exercise special Tribal criminal jurisdiction pursuant to section 813 of the Act. A framing paper that addresses the Pilot Program and possible topics for discussion will be circulated in advance of the consultations.
