INDICTMENT

COUNTS ONE - TWO

The Grand Jury charges that on the dates listed below, within the Eastern District of Tennessee, the defendant HARRISON YANG, in a matter involving a health care benefit program, knowingly and willfully, in connection with the delivery of and payment for health care benefits and services, made and used a materially false writing and document knowing the same to contain a materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statement and entry, in that he caused claims to be submitted to TennCare, a health care benefit program as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 24(b), by writing medically unnecessary prescriptions when in truth and in fact, and as the defendant then and there well knew, these prescriptions were not medically necessary:


