**ORDER**

The instant matter is before the Court for consideration of the Government's motion to dismiss the Information filed against Defendant Rolls-Royce PLC pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 48(a). (ECF No. 14). Both parties have met and conferred, and they agree that dismissal is appropriate at this time. (*Id.* at ¶ 6). Moreover, the Court has reviewed the record in this case and finds that dismissal is not "clearly contrary to manifest public interest." *See United States v. Stapleton*, 297 F. App'x 413, 431 (6th Cir. 2008) (internal quotation marks omitted). Accordingly, the Government's motion is **GRANTED** (ECF No. 14), and the Information against Defendant Rolls-Royce PLC is **DISMISSED with prejudice**. (ECF No. 3).
