INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

(Theft of Mail Matter by Postal Employee)

- 1. At all times relevant to this Information, defendant NYASIA
 HUTCHINSON was employed by the United States Postal Service as a Postal
 Service Clerk at the Elizabeth Post Office in Elizabeth, New Jersey ("EPO").
- 2. From on or about May 21, 2018, through on or about December 31, 2018, defendant NYASIA HUTCHINSON stole, from mail packages at EPO, between 15 to 20 cellular telephones (including Apple iPhones) having a total approximate value of at least \$12,246.39.
- 3. At the time they were stolen, the cellular phones were en route to a company in Hillside, New Jersey which provided addresses for customers to ship their online purchases. When a customer's package arrived at the company, the customer was notified and could then select the ultimate destination of the package and the preferred method of shipment.

4. From on or about May 21, 2018, through on or about December 31,

2018, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

NYASIA HUTCHINSON,

being a Postal Service employee, did embezzle, steal, abstract, and remove, articles

and things, namely, cellular telephones, from packages, bags, and mail, entrusted to

her and which had come into defendant NYASIA HUTCHINSON's possession

intended to be conveyed by mail, and carried and delivered by any carrier,

messenger, agent, and other person employed in any department of the Postal

Service, and forwarded through and delivered from any post office and station

thereof established by authority of the Postmaster General and of the Postal

Service.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709 and Section 2.
