ORDER

Having considered the government's Motion to Provide Alternative Victim Notification Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3771(d)(2), the Court finds that: (1) there are thousands of potential victims in this case located across the globe, many of whom have not yet been identified by the government and for whom the government has no readily available contact information; (2) it is impracticable to accord all of the potential crime victims the rights described in Section 3771(a) of the Justice for All Act of 2004 ("the Act"); (3) the "multiple crime victims" provision of the Act applies to this case; and (4) the means of notifying potential victims as set forth in the government's motion constitutes a "reasonable procedure" to give effect to and ensure compliance with the notice provisions of the Act.

Accordingly, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3771(a)(2) and 3771(d)(2), it is hereby ORDERED that the government is authorized to give notice to potential victims

in this case by posting information about the case and notice of Court proceedings on the Department of Justice's website, located at <http://www.justice.gov/largecases>, and the U.S. Attorney's Office's website, located at <http://www.justice.gov/usao/gan/vw/cases/Citadel/index.html>, as described in the government's motion.
