

Employment Opportunities for Attorneys

The United States Attorney for the Northern District of West Virginia recruits for Assistant United States Attorneys (AUSAs) in the Wheeling, Clarksburg, Elkins, and Martinsburg offices as vacancies occur.

Candidates interested in applying for attorney vacancies must have a J.D. degree; be duly licensed and authorized to practice as an attorney under the laws of a state, territory, or the District of Columbia; should have a minimum of three to five years litigation experience; and possess excellent academic credentials. Trial experience is a plus. Salary is commensurate with experience. Applicant supply files are maintained for approximately six months. For additional information please contact (304) 234-0100.

Employment for all positions is contingent upon the satisfactory completion of a background investigation by the Department of Justice. This is a thorough investigation that includes checks with present and former employers, military records, and credit bureaus. The investigation also includes verifications of tax filings and attendance at institutions of higher learning. Those who are selected are subject to drug testing by urinalysis. United States citizenship is required.
