

TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act, which requires the Attorney General from time to time to report to the Congress concerning the administration of the Act, as well as the nature, source and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed by agents of foreign principals registered under the terms of the statute.

Although the Act by its terms requires a report "from time to time," it has been the policy of the Department since 1950 to prepare a report each year in the light of the widespread interest expressed by Members of the Congress, the press and

the public in the id ntity and activity of persons acting within the United States as agents of foreign principals.

This report deals with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act for the calendar year 1961, and is in supplement to the report submitted for the calendar year 1960.

STATISTICAL SUMMARY

During 1961. a total of 89 registration statements were filed and 72 terminated. leaving 393 active registration statements on file as of December 31. 1961. This compares with 96 filed during 1960, and 376 registrations in active status on December 31, 1960. An alphabetical list of the registrants who filed during 1961 together with the name of the foreign principal and a brief description of the nature of each agency is contained in Appendix II, while a list according to registration number will be found in Appendix I. There is also in Appendix III a list of all registrants whose statements were in an active status as of December 31. 1961, set forth according to geographical area or nationality field with which the foreign principal is identified.

When a registration statement is filed by a partnership, corporation, association, organization, or other combination of individuals, each partner, officer, director, or other person rendering assistance to the registrant on behalf or in the interests of the foreign principal is required to file a short-form registration statement. During the calendar year covered by this report, 472 short-form registration statements were filed, and these are listed alphabetically in Appendix IV. In comparison, 402 short-form registration statements were filed in 1960. The identity of the registrant in support of whose statement the short-form registration statement was filed may be ascertained by consulting Appendix I in correlation with the registration number.

As in previous years, the largest number of new registration statements was filed by persons or organizations engaging in publicity, public relations, advertising, or allied activities for the purpose of swaying and conciliating American public opinion. Classification of statements according to the principal function reported is found in Appendix V.

LEGISLATION

The Act of October 4, 1961 (75 Stat. 78, amended the Foreign Agents Registration Act in the following respects:

First, it enlarged the definition of the term "foreign principal" by making it include "a domestic partnership, association, corporation, organization or other combination of individuals, supervised, directed, controlled or financed, in whole or in substantial part, by any foreign government or foreign political party." Prior to this amendment, only a domestic partnership, association, corporation, organization, or other combination of individuals, which was subsidized, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by a foreign government or foreign political party, was included within the definition of a "foreign principal."

Second, the so-called commercial and trade exemption in Section 3(d) of the Act, which had previously applied to "any person engaging or agreeing to engage only in private, nonpolitical, financial, mercantile, or other activities in furtherance of the bona fide trade or commerce of [a] foreign

principal," was made to apply to "any person engaging or agreeing to engage only in private and nonpolitical financial or mercantile activities in furtherance of the bona fide trade or commerce of [a] foreign principal." The words "private." "nonpolitical." "financial." and "mercantile" could possibly be construed as limitation and not description, each qualifying in the disjunctive the "activities" undertaken by an agent of a foreign principal. Bydeleting the word "others" in reference to "activities" and making the words "private" and "nonpolitical" qualify in the conjunctive the financial or mercantile activities engaged in by an agent in furtherance of the bona fide trade or commerce of his foreign principal. the amendment has served to give more precision to the scope of the exemption from the registration requirements provided in Section 3(d) and to support the Department's position that this exemption is available only when the agent's activities on behalf of his foreign principal are private as well as commercial and not when the activities meet only one of these criteria.

ENFORCEMENT

compliance with the requirements of the Act is generally obtained through established administrative procedures, as evidenced by the steady increase over the years in the total number of registration statements filed. Nevertheless, it was necessary during the period under consideration to institute prosecution in the following case:

On December 8, 1961, a three count indictment was returned in the District of Columbia against Prensa Latina Agencia Informativa Latinoamericana, Sociedad Anonima, and Francisco V. Portela, its chief correspondent in New York. Prensa Latina, a corporation organized under the laws of Cuba for the purpose of engaging in the business of an international news agency, was charged with failure to register as an agent within the United States of the Cuban Government. Francisco V. Portela was charged with failure to cause Prensa Latina to register under the Act as well as with failure to register himself as an agent of Prensa Latina, a foreign principal as defined in the Act. 1

^{1/} On April 18, 1962, Prensa Latina entered a plea of nolo contendere to the indictment and was fined \$2,000. The indictment as against the individual defendant was dismissed.

A solicitation of registration in August 1961 led to the filing of a complaint on November 15, 1961, by Victor Rabinowitz and Leonard B. Boudin, attorneys in New York, seeking a declaratory judgment that their activities as legal representatives for the Government of the Republic of Cuba did not require their registration under the Act. 2/

NATURE, SOURCES AND CONTENT OF POLITICAL PROPAGANDA

As in past years, the largest source of political propaganda continues to emanate from official foreign government information and tourist offices. This material is designed primarily for the promotion of good will and to present to the American public particular viewpoints on various national and international issues. It is also designed to stimulate trade with and travel to foreign lands. The expenditure in the United States of over 11 million dollars by official foreign government information and tourist offices continues to reflect the importance placed by these governments on American trade and

tourism. A tabl showing the expenditures of the foreign government information and tourist offices registered under the Act will be found in Appendix VI.

Foreign governments continue to employ the services of American public relations firms for advice as to the nature and content of their political propaganda material and a number rely upon American law firms for advice and consultation. Appendix VII contains a summary showing the amount of money received by American individuals and organizations from their foreign principals during the calendar year covered by the report. Included in this listing are the names of American public relations advisers and consultants who have been retained by foreign governments during the year 1961.

The stream of propaganda material will ebb and flow in accordance with the intensity of the issues facing the foreign government or foreign political party which is trying to influence American public opinion. Following is an analysis of the principal trends noted during 1961 in the propaganda materials from the geographical areas listed below:

Algeria. The Algerian Front of National Liberation continued to disseminate during 1961, through its office in New York City, press releases and pamphlets dealing with the Algerian struggle with France for self-determination. This material contained numerous statements issued by the provisional government of the Algerian Republic, speeches made by officials of that government and other material presenting the Algerian point of view, such as editorials published in "El Moudjahid," the central organ of the Algerian Front of National Liberation.

Material from non-Algerian sources was also disseminated by that office, such as comments on Algeria by Mennen Williams, United States Assistant Secretary of State for African Affairs, reports by American newspaper correspondents, statements by French Labor Organizations, an appeal signed by 82 French intellectuals and a resolution adopted at the Lille Conference of French political and intellectual leaders.

Distribution was also made of extracts from an article entitled "The Algerian Conflict and the Rule of Law," which appeared in the Bulletin of the International Commission of Jurists, December 1960.

Arab States. The Arab Information Center, which represents the Governments of Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Tunisia, United Arab Republic and Yemen continued to disseminate a wide variety of material including press releases, pamphlets, films and records, a monthly magazine entitled "The Arab World" and a semimonthly news report called "Arab News and Views."

According to the information submitted in its registration statement, the Center expended approximately \$45,000 more for its operations in 1961 than in 1960. This increase in expenditure was also accompanied by a general increase in the circulation of its printed material. The dissemination reports filed in 1961 by the Center pursuant to the Act indicated that the monthly distribution of the combined copies of the pamphlets, "Arab News and Views" and "The Arab World" varied between approximately 37,000 and 87,000 persons and organizations. This material was distributed by hand and by mail from the New York address of the Center.

The dissemination reports also set forth the approximate number of institutions or individuals

connect d with institutions which received distribution material. This listing represents a fairly fixed dissemination with the highest numbers in the following categories: newspapers, educators, writers, scholars, researchers, libraries, United States clergymen, nongovernmental organizations, Arabs, Americans of Arab origin, Arab clergymen and students, and the general public. In addition, the Center also distributed material to embassies, radio and television stations, United Nations delegations and Secretariat members, travel agents, Congressmen and Government officials, business and public relations leaders and world affairs organizations.

The Palestine Arab Refugee Office continued to disseminate news releases and pamphlets in support of the cause of the Arab inhabitants of the former Palestine area. The Arab refugee problem was also highlighted in the material distributed by the Palestine Arab Delegation which registered in 1961 as an agent for the Arab Higher Committee for Palestine. According to the dissemination reports filed by the Palestine Arab Refugee Office, the total circulation of their pamphlet entitled "The Expulsion of the Palestine Arabs from their Homeland" amounted to

about 8,000 copies. The general circulation in 1961 of each newsletter distributed by the Palestine Arab Delegation was 2.500 copies.

Cuba. The Movimiento 26 de Julio (July 26th Movement), New York, the registered agent of a Cuban political party of the same name, disseminated various propaganda material in both the English and Spanish languages. This consisted mostly of reprints of speeches delivered by Fidel Castro and other leading Cuban officials before the United Nations, OAS Conferences and other forums. Additional material dealt with various topics which either lauded the accomplishments of the Castro revolution or condemned the policy of the United States in the Caribbean area.

Other Cuban propaganda material made available to the Department included samples of Spanish language newspapers, periodicals and pamphlets which had been shipped from Havana to the several Cuban missions to the United Nations for further dissemination. Among this material were official newspapers, periodicals and literature published by agencies of the Cuban Government or by publishers under its control.

Ghana. Ghana Information S rvic s diss minat d during the year a bimonthly pictorial magazine called "Ghana Today." Prominence was given to President Nkrumah's visit to Eastern Europe and to his proposals for world peace made at the Conference of Heads of State of non-aligned countries in Belgrade. Considerable space was also given to the visit of Queen Elizabeth of England and the Duke of Edinburgh to Ghana, and to President Nkrumah's comments to the effect that the wind of change would not alter the affection of the Ghanaian people for the royal couple.

A new era of socialist reconstruction was ushered in, according to a speech by the Minister of Light and Heavy Industries on the subject of the Government's action in dissolving the Industrial Development and the Agricultural Development Corporations. According to a report published in "Ghana Today" the Minister told a meeting of members and senior personnel of State-owned companies that henceforth all companies would exist only if they justifi d their existence by operating as profitable ventures.

Great Britain. The British Information Services (BIS) continued to distribute a daily summary of the principal comments found in British newspapers, in a

publication entitled "Today's British Papers." It also distributed the text of statements by British Government officials, such as a statement by the British Representative at the United Nations on Soviet nuclear testing, a speech by the Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations on African Affairs, and a letter of the British Ambassador to President Kennedy thanking him for hurricane aid extended to the people of British Honduras.

In addition, BIS published its own brief comments on political and economic developments and other items of interest. Also of interest was a Scientific and Technical News Service distributed by BIS which related to the latest developments primarily in the field of Atomic Energy in Britain.

BIS also disseminated lengthy pamphlets dealing in detail with subjects thought to merit special treatment, such as the emergence of Tanganyika as an independent state, constitutional development in the Commonwealth and United Kingdom and technical assistance for overseas development.

India. India had no alternative, according to its daily news release "Indiagram," but to send troops

into Goa on December 18, 1961, to give stability and help to th Goans after the failur of the Portuguese colonial administration. The "Indiagram" claimed moral justification for the action in Goa. India was not going into a foreign country, it explained, but only to a part of India under illegal Portuguese occupation. Throughout this literature was indication of India's resolve to maintain the integrity of her territory and the effective defense of her frontiers. This material was distributed by the Information Service of India, operating from the Embassy of India, Washington, D.C.

The Information Service also disseminated an "India Economic Newsletter," addresses by the Indian Ambassador, Mr. B. K. Nehru, a Joint Soviet-Indian Communique, speeches by Prime Minister Nehru, and on December 17, 1961, a pamphlet edition of the "Facts About Goa."

Another theme treated in the material filed by the Information Service of India was the need for total world disarmament. India proclaimed its "unshakable decision" not to acquire nuclear weapons, stating that peace would not be achieved by extending the area of war. It deplored the Soviet resumption of

nuclear tests and discussed India's resolution in the Political Committee of the U.N. General Assembly to ban testing. The "Indiagram" praised the Indian response to the United Nations call for action in the Congo.

Concurrently with the foregoing topics,

Indian literature advocated its familiar tenets of
peaceful coexistence and non-alignment, while noting
Pakistan's "military mentality" in Kashmir and the
Chinese incursions in the Indian mountain territory.

Indonesia. Daily news briefs were disseminated by the Information Division of the Embassy of Indonesia, Washington, through a publication entitled "Djakarta Dispatches." The policy pursued by the Netherlands in West Irian (New Guinea) took up the greater portion of the copy. According to the "Dispatches," there would be conflict so long as the Dutch exercised colonial domination over West Irian. Indonesia's stand, it declared, had always been and would continue to be recognition of Indonesia's sovereignty over West Irian by the Netherlands.

Back in print in November was the "Report on Indonesia," a monthly magazine providing insights into Indonesian life, and published and distributed without charg by the Embassy.

The Jewish Agency for Israel disseminated Israel. press releases, occasional pamphlets, photographs, and a pictorial magazine for youth entitled "Israel Youth Horizon." In addition, the Agency distributed a bulletin and a guide sheet prepared by the Department of Education and Culture of the American Zionist Council. Featured among the publications disseminated by the Agency is the "Israel Digest of Press and Events in Israel and the Middle East." a fortnightly publication with news commentaries covering foreign affairs. economic achievements and educational. scientific and cultural developments. The dissemination reports filed during the year 1961 by the Jewish Agency reflected that about 17,000 copies of each issue of the Israel Digest were disseminated, that there were no bulk mailings and that 1.200 libraries or individuals connected therewith and 2,000 newspapers or other publications received copies of the Digest.

The Israel Office of Information continued to disseminate press releases, speeches, special statements, pamphlets, documents and films. In addition, this Office provided material for two weekly radio programs, "Vistas of Israel" and "Israel Press Review," as well as other programs.

According to the dissemination reports filed by the Israel Office of Information, 12,000 copies of its newsletter "The Land of the Bible" were distributed monthly. The Office also disseminated approximately 1,000 copies of a pamphlet entitled "The Realities of the Arab Refugee Problem" as well as a kit on the Eichmann Trial containing a copy of the full text of the indictment of Adolf Eichmann, a copy of the statute under which he was indicted together with two commentaries on "Eichmann and the Question of Jurisdiction" and "The Role of Law in International Affairs as Illustrated by the Eichmann Case."

Japan. Trade was the subject which received the most mphasis in Japan's propaganda material. To increase the flow between the United States and Japan was the principal concern of the United States-Japan Trade Council, Washington, D.C., which, according to its registration statement, is a non-profit association of 300 American business firms conducting trade with Japan. This Council published bimonthly fact sheets to provide editors with useful data about foreign trade as well as ten to fifteen pamphlets a year on various aspects of United States-Japan trade.

The keynote in this propaganda material was the significance to the United States and the free world of a liberal trade policy. According to the Council, a retreat into protectionism would place United States export markets in jeopardy and in the long run imperil rather than assist the United States balance of payments. Furthermore, international wage comparisons in dollars and cents were meaningless, the Council stated, because many factors entered into any realistic calculation of comparative costs of production.

From its headquarters on New York's Fifth

Avenue came photographs and press releases of Japanese products promoted by the Japan Trade Center, a service of the Japan External Trade Organization, a semi-governmental organization. The public relations agency of Ruder & Finn, Inc., has sparked interest in exhibitions of Japanese leisure goods, fancy foods and light machinery.

Korea. Internal pressures resulted in a change in the content and format of Korean propaganda during 1961.

Previous to the May military revolution, the Korean Research and Information Office, Washington, D.C., an agent of the Republic of Korea, had published a monthly

magazine, "Kor an Survey," describing Kor a's cultur and economy. In May of 1961, the Information Office began publishing "Korea Report," a bimonthly magazine which is intended to inform the American people of current events, the cultural heritage and social life of Korea.

Emphasis was placed on the objectives of the Military Revolutionary Committee. Anti-communism was declared to be the principal national policy.

The Committee stated that its aim was to eradicate corruption and create a fresh morale. It cautioned that the temporary suspension of democratic government in the Republic of Korea did not imply the permanent destruction of democratic principles. The "Korea Report" declared that both the leaders and people of Korea were determined to establish a constitutional civilian government as soon as possible, hopefully by the summer of 1963.

"Korea Photo News," apparently transmitted directly from Korea, is published and printed in English by the Korea Information Service, Inc., of Seoul, on a quarterly basis. Six times a year, a 4-page edition of "The Voice of Korea" was published by the Korean Affairs Institute, a non-profit organization in Washington. D.C.

Pakistan. President Ayub Khan's state visit to the United Stat s in July was the predominant vent publicized in "Pakistan Affairs," a semimonthly paper issued by the Embassy of Pakistan, Washington, D.C. In the news briefs appearing in this publication could also be discerned the main currents of Pakistan's foreign policy.

Pakistan was concerned with its territorial security as well as with its "ideological integration," which would be accomplished by making the Islamic way of life the life-pattern of the people of Pakistan. "Pakistan Affairs" emphasized Pakistan's persistent but unsuccessful efforts to make India's Nehru see the urgency of resolving the Kashmir dispute. It described as "autocratic" Mr. Nehru's attitude in refusing a Kashmir plebiscite.

With respect to Afghanistan's severance of diplomatic relations, Pakistan stressed in its publications that it had no aggressive designs against Afghanistan and only wished its rulers would confine their activities to the welfare of their own people.

In addition, Pakistan noted the increasing interest of private investors in the opportunities to be found in Pakistan.

People's Republic of China. Red China propaganda was disseminated during the year by Imported Publications and Products, New York, and China Books and Periodicals, Chicago. Included in this material were the "Peking Review," a weekly news magazine; two illustrated monthlies, "China Pictorial" and "China Reconstructs;" "Women of China;" numerous bound works by Mao Tse-Tung, politically slanted novels, ghost stories and songs. The recurrent theme was the reactionary line of the Tito clique of Yugoslavia which had caused its social system to degenerate into capitalism and thus serve U.S. imperialism, while Albania was working to build socialism and carried on its struggle against imperialism and its stooges, the Yugoslav modern revisionists.

According to this propaganda, U.S. imperialism was seeking to undermine the Asian people's
struggle for national independence and liberation.
Red China propaganda claimed that the United States
aimed at burying the Geneva agreements and using the
prestige of neutral countries to legalize the rebel
clique in Laos to facilitate its aggression and
interference.

It spoke of the United States "occupation" of South Korea by force to impede the peaceful unification of Korea and insisted that the United States is obstructing the restoration of China's legitimate rights by its occupation of Taiwan.

There was only one China, according to this propaganda, the People's Republic of China, and Taiwan was an inseparable part of this territory. It boasted of Red China's treaty of friendship with Indonesia,

Nepal and Burma, and the protocol on goods exchanged with the U.S.S.R., and it praised the Soviet Union for its decision to resume nuclear testing as a "cooling dose for hot-headed war-plotters."

Portugal. Selvage and Lee, Inc., on behalf of the Overseas Companies of Portugal, disseminated during the year brochures, statements, and memoranda primarily dealing with the problems arising in connection with the Portuguese Province of Angola.

Noteworthy were statements deploring the fact that the United States sided with the Soviet Union and against Portugal in votes at the United Nations.

Prominence was also given to a speech by Premier Salazar of Portugal. delivered at a session of the

National Assembly of Portugal, in which he attacked the United States policy of supporting the Afro-Asian group at the United Nations. A great deal of emphasis was given to the charge that much of the trouble in Angola came from Communist sources, and alarm and surprise were expressed over the alleged fact that much of the Communist propaganda about Portugal had found ready acceptance in the United States. For example, the American Committee on Africa, which allegedly included many prominent citizens of this country among its members, was said to repeat the Communist charges against Portugal.

A memorandum entitled "Missionaries and Angola" asserted that certain Protestant religious groups were making exaggerated claims regarding their missionaries in Angola, particularly insofar as their imprisonment was concerned.

Also of interest were statements to the effect that the Portuguese, for centuries, have pursued an enlightened multi-racial policy, and that the Negroes in Portugal and its possessions have achieved a de jure and de facto equality of treatment, for which the Negroes in the United States are still striving.

Republic of China. Blocking the admission of Red China to the United Nations was the principal thrust of the "Free China Weekly," a news digest published weekly by the Chinese News Service, an information agency of the Government of the Republic of China. The digest noted the five year interest-free loan of the Peiping regime to the Castro regime in Cuba, while Chinese on the mainland were starving, and declared that the Peiping regime is ready to serve the cause of international Communism at the expense of the Chinese people. The News Service supported the Republic in its attempt to bar entry of Mongolia to the United Nations, calling it a Soviet tool of aggression, and viewed the UN's dealings with Outer Mongolia as a retreat in principle.

The digest remarked upon increasing foreign investments within the Republic of China, especially from Japan and the United States. It particularly emphasized that the "Two-Chinas" policy would never be acceptable and expressed the hope of restoring freedom to the Chinese on the mainland.

Republic of South Africa. The Information Service of South Africa disseminated a bimonthly pictorial magazine called "South African Scope" which dealt with

the political, economic and cultural developments of South Africa. Of interest was an article entitled "Bantu Initiative Reaps Rich Rewards" which asserted that the income and buying power of South Africa's Bantu had increased at such an amazing rate that today they owned four times as many motor cars per person as the Russians. According to this article, the latest figures revealed that the 10,800,000 Bantu possessed 100,000 automobiles compared with 575,000 for the 209,000,000 people in the Soviet Union.

Another article pointed out that slums had been virtually eliminated in South Africa's urban Bantu areas as a result of the largest rehousing program ever launched in the Southern Hemisphere.

Also of interest was a summary of an address to the Philosophical Society of Imperial Chemical Industries by Dr. Hilgard Muller, South African Ambassador to the United Kingdom. Dr. Muller stated that racial prejudice could be avoided and justice for all the people of South Africa achieved only by the policy of apartheid, the policy of separate development. According to Dr. Muller, when two nationalisms were brought into play within the confines of one political system, one was bound to

dominate or absorb the other, and there could be no question of blending a mixture.

Prominence was also given to an opening statement by Foreign Minister Eric H. Louw at the meeting of the Special Political Committee of the United Nations when it discussed South Africa's racial policy. According to Mr. Louw, there was a growing tendency in the United Nations to apply a double standard for judging the actions of Member States, one for the great and strong and another for the small and weak nations -- one for large groups of nations, for example the Afro-Asian bloc, and another for a country like South Africa which was not a member of a particular bloc or group. If the United Nations was to play its part in world affairs, it could ill afford a double standard policy, Mr. Louw told the Special Political Committee.

U.S.S.R. Included among the major items of Soviet propaganda disseminated in the United States were a weekly news magazine, "New Times;" a monthly journal of political analysis, "International Affairs;" "The Moscow News," a weekly newspaper; several illustrat d monthly magazines: "Culture and Life," "Soviet Woman," and "Soviet Union;" booklet reprints of Lenin's

writings, documents of th 22nd Congr ss of the CPSU, and pamphlets on Soviet space triumphs. These continued as in the past to stress Lenin's prediction that socialism would exert its greatest effect on the advance of world revolution by its economic successes. The "Programme of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union," published on October 31, 1961, proclaimed that by 1980, the U.S.S.R. would have the world's highest material productivity level.

Soviet propaganda spoke of the "twilight of capitalism" and offered the cosmic flights of Gagarin and Titov as proof that socialism had outstripped capitalism in several key branches of science and technology. Emphasis was placed on a statement by Prime Minister Macmillan of Great Britain that the real test would not be on the battlefield, but in the market-place. In the light of this, Soviet propaganda reiterated its desire for peaceful coexistence, seeking, as it claimed, to form the basis for peaceful competition between socialism and capitalism on an international scale.

Soviet propaganda materials claimed that the U.S.S.R. was forced to resume nuclear weapons testing during 1961 because of the increasing aggressiveness

of the NATO military bloc. They attributed the disarmament stalemate to the Western Powers whose policy supposedly was determined by big business which encouraged the arms race. Blame for the impasse on a control and inspection plan was also placed upon the West. the Soviets asserting that the proposed Western plan would in effect legalize Western espionage on Soviet soil. The UN post of Secretary General came under fire with the U.S.S.R. seeking to institute instead a three-man executive body to achieve "equal footing" in the United Nations. Of all the propaganda themes found in Soviet propaganda, however, the most persistent was the Soviet's demand that a German peace treaty be signed before the end of 1961, accompanied by a threat to sign a treaty with whatever states were willing.

Dissemination of U.S.S.R. propaganda materials in the United States was handled by Four Continent
Book Corporation, Imported Publications and Products,
Crosscurrents Press, Inc., Crossworld Books and
Periodicals, Inc., and World Books. The "USSR Illustrated Monthly" was distributed primarily from the
Soviet Embassy and through Select Magazines. Inc.

Yugoslavia. The principal source of Yugoslavian propaganda disseminated within the United States continues to be the Yugoslav Information Center in New York, an agency of the Yugoslav Government. According to the weekly "Yugoslav News Bulletin," published by the Center, President Tito called on the non-aligned countries to extend their joint action to economic questions. He condemned the pressure of so-called "U.S. reactionaries" to cut aid and sale of what and other products to Yugoslav propaganda, that Yugoslavia is not seeking aid but economic cooperation on the basis of equality.

One of the expressed objectives of the Yugoslav Information Center propaganda material was to remove the deficit in Yugoslavia's foreign trade - to promote its economic relations in every area and with every country in a spirit of active coexistence. To achieve this end, it was claimed that Yugoslavia sought to develop the best possible relations with all countries willing to do so, regardless of the differences in their social systems or views on international problems.

A r current topic throughout th year was the critical anti-Yugoslav attacks by China and Albania, the "News Bulletin" stating that these "professional provocateurs" attack all that is progressive in the international workers! movement.

approaches to socialism followed by the U.S.S.R. and Yugoslavia. Russia, according to the material disseminated, believed that each country committed to socialism had to be in the socialist camp, while Yugoslavia insisted socialism could be built without participation in such a bloc formation of states. The "News Bulletin" explained that each country should and could develop its socialist system in its own way, according to its own conditions, yet still maintain cooperation with other socialist countries.

In addition to the weekly "News Bulletin," numerous pamphlets replete with statistics were distributed by the Information Center. They extolled the economic system in Yugoslavia and discussed citizens' housing rights, workers' management, agricultural cooperatives, ship-building and an array of other topics. Mimeographed sheets entitled "Yugoslav Facts and Views" were disseminated intermittently by the Information Center. These contained

intervi ws, sp eches and policy statements by Yugoslav officials.

Also mailed directly from Belgrade was the "Review of International Affairs," a magazine published twice a month by the Federation of Yugoslav Journalists. Its index page described it as a forum for the free exchange of ideas by Yugoslav and foreign authors in the domain of politics and economics.

Registration under the Act does not imply recognition by the United States Government either of the de jure existence or legality of the foreign principal nor does registration indicate approval by the United States Government of the propaganda material disseminated by the registered agent.

The principal purpose of Congress in enacting the Foreign Agents Registration Act was to require public disclosure by persons engaging in propaganda activities and other activities for or on behalf of foreign governments, foreign political parties and other foreign principals, so that the Government and the people of the United States may be informed of the identity of such persons and may

appraise their statements and actions in the light of their associations and activities. The emphasis of the Department of Justice in its administration of the statute has been toward the achievement of this purpose. In performing its functions, the Department has continued to rely upon its normal sources of information and upon the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
