

REPORT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL
TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES
ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
FOREIGN AGENTS REGISTRATION ACT OF 1938, AS AMENDED

June 1951

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TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act which reads:

The Attorney General shall, from time to time, make a report to Congress concerning the administration of this Act, including the nature, sources, and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed.

This report is concerned with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act for the calendar year 1950. It is submitted in supplement to the report of the Attorney General to the Congress on the administration and enforcement of the Act submitted in June 1950 and covering the five-year period commencing January 1, 1945 and ending December 31, 1949.

Two major amendments to the Foreign Agents Registration Act were enacted in 1950. By amendment of August 3, 1950, the Congress provided

that the dissolution of an organization which has been acting as an agent of a foreign principal does not relieve such agent from the obligation to file a registration statement for the period during which it acted within the United States as an agent of a foreign principal nor relieve any officer or director or person performing those functions from complying with the registration provisions of the Act. At the same time, it was provided that the obligation of an agent to file a registration statement was a continuing one.

The Foreign Agents Registration Act was again amended by Section 20 of Title 1 of the Internal Security Act which became law on September 23, 1950. Section 20(a) amended Section 1(c) of the Act by providing for a new class of agents of foreign principals, namely, persons who have knowledge of or have received instruction or assignment in the espionage, counterespionage or sabotage service or tactics of a government of a foreign country or of a foreign political party. Section 20(b) reemphasized the fact of continuing obligation by strengthening the existing legislation in providing that failure to file required registration statements or supplements should be a continuing offense for as long as such failure exists notwithstanding any statute of limitations or other statute to the contrary.

As required by the Foreign Agents Registration Act, within ten days of enactment of the amendment contained in Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act, it was necessary to issue additional regulations to implement this legislation. These regulations and an additional form to accomplish the registration of the new class of agents created

by the amendment were prepared and issued and the regulations were published in the Federal Register within the required period.

No registration statements pursuant to Section 20(a) were received prior to the end of the calendar year 1950 and no prosecutions were initiated under this new section during the period covered by this report. The Department has initiated an examination into its responsibilities under the amendment.

In the five-year period covered by the last report of the Attorney General to the Congress a total of 317 new registrations were received and 278 terminated. In 1950, 51 registration statements were filed and 46 were terminated, so that at the close of the calendar year there were 218 active registration statements in the Department's file. A list of all persons who have filed public registration statements in the twelve months period between January 1, 1950 and December 31, 1950 is contained in Appendix No. 1. The registrants are listed in this appendix according to registration number and those registrations which have been terminated are indicated by an asterisk.

Appendix II consists of an alphabetical list of registrants whose statements were filed during 1950. Terminations are again denoted by an asterisk. The appendix also contains the names of the foreign principals as listed by the registrants and a brief statement of the nature of the agency.

Appendix III lists all of the registration statements filed with the Department which were in active status as of December 31, 1950,

presented according to geographical areas or the nationality field which that agency represents.

Appendix IV lists alphabetically each individual who filed during 1950 in support of a registration statement an Exhibit A or short form registration statement which is permitted for officials, directors, employees or other persons rendering assistance to the registrant when the statement itself is filed in the name of a partnership, corporation, committee, organization or other combination of individuals.

Appendix V consists of a functional analysis of statements as reported by the registrant. The 1950 registration statements show that the largest single category is the field of advertising and publicity, including travel information and trade promotion agents. There are seven registrations each for official foreign government information centers, attorneys and commercial and financial agents or representatives.

Appendix VI represents a breakdown of expenditures of foreign government information and tourist offices whose statements were in active status during 1950 and is based on the reports filed by these offices. This appendix also sets forth the number of employees of each of these government information and tourist offices as reflected in their registration statements.

The nature and content of political propaganda issued by registered agents of foreign principals during 1950 have not changed materially from that described in my previous report to the Congress

from January 1, 1945 to December 31, 1949. The largest segment of propaganda distributed in this country continues to be publications designed to build up good will in the United States toward the country which is issuing the propaganda, including travel and trade promotional literature. Many questions which were the subject of political tracts in the years following World War II were still a source of propaganda in 1950: the status of China and Formosa, the independence of India and of the United States of Indonesia, and the conflict of the Tito Government with the Soviet Union. New issues, of course, arose during 1950, especially the outbreak of the war in Korea and for the first time since World War II information was disseminated regarding Germany.

The degree of interest on the part of other nations in publicizing their points of view and in advocating good will is shown by the fact that the greatest volume of political propaganda came from official government agencies or organizations subsidized by such governments. Chief among these in regard to the amount of material filed with the Department are:

Although the total number of information and travel offices maintained by foreign governments in this country during 1950 increased only from

41 to 43, six new offices were established:

Danish National Travel Office
Egyptian Information Center
German Tourist Information Office
Israel National Tourist Center
Netherlands National Tourist Office
South African Tourist Corporation

On the other hand, the Greek Government discontinued its office of Information, the Haitian News Center discontinued operations, the Canadian Information Office transferred its informational activities to the Embassy in Washington and the Consulate in New York, and the Panama National Tourist Office temporarily suspended reporting its activities because of contemplated reorganization.

The government information and tourist offices reported in their statements filed with this Department expenditures during 1950 totaling almost \$5,000,000, representing an increase of more than \$800,000 over the previous year, although the total number of employees decreased from 611 in 1949 to 558 in 1950. The largest single expenditure in 1950 was again reported by the British Information Services which issues voluminous tourist and travel promotional literature regarding Great Britain. As indicated in the previous report to the Congress, the registration statements reflect no amounts expended for propaganda purposes in the United States by the Soviet Union and its satellites since these countries conduct their propaganda activities directly through their embassies or legations and, accordingly, come within the exemption provisions of the Foreign Agents Registration Act.

Another factor affecting the nature and content of political propaganda is the emergence of groups of refugees from Communist

controlled countries whose objectives are the liberation of their respective countries from Communist domination. Indicative of such movement has been the establishment in the United States of the Polish Freedom Movement, the National Committee for the Liberation of Slovakia, the Slovak Liberation Committee, the Polish Political Council and the Slovak National Council Abroad. The pattern thus emerging is in some respects similar to that which existed during the years when these countries were overrun by the National Socialist Government of Germany.


International developments may render it desirable again to invoke the exemption provisions of Section 3(f) of the Foreign Agents Registration Act which was withdrawn in 1946. By the provisions of Section 3(f), a person whose foreign principal is a government of a foreign country, the defense of which the President has declared to be vital to the defense of the United States, may under certain circumstances file with the Department an informative statement in lieu of registration, which statements may in the public interest be withheld from the public file of registrations. The provisions of this section were invoked by the President during the years from 1942 to 1946 and a list of all persons who filed these so-called allied government statements in lieu of public registration statements is contained in the previous report to the Congress.

The main emphasis in the administration of the Act has been and will continue to be the achievement of full disclosure of activities within the United States by agents of foreign principals who are engaged in political propaganda activities. While no prosecutions were instituted during 1950, the Department pursued its investigation

and preparation of the case against the Peace Information Center, distributors of the Stockholm peace pledge in the United States. The Center and its officers were indicted soon after the close of the calendar year 1950.

As I previously pointed out to the Congress, the curtailment of activities of the Department at the close of World War II resulted in the discontinuance of the unit engaged in analyzing foreign language materials. During 1950, therefore, reliance continued to be placed on the Department's normal sources of information and investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
