TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act, which requires the Attorney General from time to time to report to the Congress concerning the administration of the Act, as well as the nature, source and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed by agents of foreign principals registered under the terms of the statute.

This report deals with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act for the calendar year 1956, and is in supplement to the report submitted in June of that year covering the calendar year 1955, which in turn supplemented the report covering the five-year period commencing January 1, 1950 and ending December 31, 1954, and which was submitted in June, 1955.

The year period covered by the report saw a number of significant developments in connection with the administration of the Act. The rules and regulations promulgated by the Attorney General were revised or amended, while the statute itself was amended by the repeal of Section 1(c)(5) [Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950]. While the number of new registration statements filed in 1956 was not as great as in 1955, there were more statements in an active status at the close of 1956 than at any other time since the administration of the Act was transferred to the Department of Justice in 1942. One criminal prosecution was instituted for violation of the registration provisions of the statute. This is the first such prosecution since 1951, which is indicative of the extent to which voluntary compliance with the Act is obtained through administrative procedures.

STATISTICAL SUMMARY

In 1956, 63 new registration statements were filed pursuant to the Act, and 38 statements terminated, leaving 307 active registration statements on file as of December 31, 1956. An alphabetical list of the registrants who filed statements in 1956, together with the name of the foreign principal and a brief description of the nature of each agency is contained

in Appendix II, while a list by registration number will be found in Appendix I.

During the calendar year, 290 short form registrations were filed by partners, officers, directors, or other persons rendering assistance to registrants which are partnerships, corporations, associations, organizations or other combinations of individuals, for or in the interest of the foreign principals of such registrants. Short form registration statements are listed in Appendix IV. The identity of the registrant in support of whose statement a short form registration statement was filed may be ascertained by reference to Appendix I, through correlation of the registration number.

Prior to the repeal of Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950, infra, three new registration statements were filed by persons defined as agents of foreign principals by the terms of that Section, bringing to a total of 90 the registration statements filed pursuant thereto.

As in the past, the largest number of new registration statements were filed by persons engaged in
publicity, public relations, advertising, or allied
activities, on behalf of foreign principals. The second
largest class of registrants consists of those engaged

in legal and economic consulting services. A relaxation of restrictions upon tourist travel by the Soviet bloc countries is reflected in the registration statements filed by seven firms acting in the United States as travel agents of the state-controlled tourist companies of nations of Eastern Europe. A table showing the classification of statements according to the principal function reported will be found in Appendix III.

NATURE, SOURCE AND CONTENT OF POLITICAL PROPAGANDA

Materials disseminated by official foreign government information and tourist offices and by foreign political parties are the largest sources of political propaganda disseminated in the United States. Such materials aim, in the main, for the promotion of good will, and are designed to present to the American public particular viewpoints on various national and international issues. Many publications are designed to stimulate trade with and travel to foreign lands. The expenditure of over 6.8 million dollars and the employment of 626 persons in the United States by official foreign government information and tourist offices reflect the continued importance of American trade and tourism in the economies of such foreign nations. The new registrations of three government tourist offices

in 1956 brings the total of such registered offices to 51, representing 32 different foreign countries.

Many countries employ the services of American public relations concerns and consultants, with regard to the nature and content of the political propaganda material disseminated by them to the American public.

A table showing the expenditures and number of employees of all foreign government information and tourist offices registered under the Act will be found in Appendix VI, while Appendix VII contains a summary showing the amount of money received by American individuals and organizations from their foreign principals during the calendar year covered by the report. Included in the latter list are the names of all American public relations advisers and consultants who have been retained by foreign governments during the period.

A list of registered agents whose statements were in an active status as of December 31, 1956, set forth according to geographic area or nationality field, will be found in Appendix V.

There were no outstanding increases or decreases in the expenditures of official government information and tourist offices in 1956. The greatest expenditure by any one government, an amount in excess of 2.1 million

dollars, was made by Great Britain, in financing the activities within the United States of the British Broad-casting Corporation, the British Information Services, and the British Travel Association.

Propaganda materials have been disseminated in the United States by disputing nations for the purpose of swaying American public opinion in the direction of the objectives and policies of such nations. In this regard, it is observed that the Israel Office of Information reported expenditures of over \$205,000 in 1956, a decrease of approximately \$16,000 from that nation's expenditure during the previous year, while the Arab Information Center reported the expenditure of \$135,000, an increase of \$25,000 over the amount spent in 1955.

Following is an analysis of the principal trends noted during 1956 in the propaganda materials of the nations listed below.

Japan

As in previous years, the propaganda of Japan dealt with the improvement of Japanese-American trade relations, with emphasis upon the Japanese textile industry. A number of pamphlets published by the Council for Improved United States-Japanese Trade Relations were concerned with laws passed by a number of our States requiring firms dealing in Japanese textiles to place a

sign upon their doors to that effect.

The promotion of tourism to Japan is the principal theme of publications which are issued by the Japanese Consulate General in New York City.

Germany

"The Bulletin," issued by the Press and Information Office of the German Federal Government, is a weekly survey of German affairs. Topics such as the return of the Saar, the unification of Germany, and the integration of Europe for mutual defense were dealt with.

France

As in the past, most French propaganda dealt with France's economic achievements and tourist facilities. The bi-weekly report "France Actuelle," featuring articles on economic and political developments, dealt with such topics as the Common European Market, France's policies in North Africa, and the possibilities of increased France-American trade.

Turkey

The Turkish Information Office distributes a weekly bulletin entitled "News From Turkey," which presents the Turkish point of view with respect to internal and international affairs. Of prominence regarding the latter is Turkey's interest in Cyprus and

the affairs of the Middle East.

North Africa

The representative of the Algerian Delegation of the Front of National Liberation, Cairo, Egypt, disseminates "Free Algeria," a newsletter presenting the Algerian position regarding such alleged French injustices as inadequate educational facilities and the lack of an Arabic language newspaper. Matters such as the Algerian position respecting native land ownership are also treated.

Israel

The material distributed by the Israel Office of Information dealt primarily with the Arab-Israeli conflict and the events leading up to Israel's operations in the Sinai Peninsula. "Israeli Digest," a weekly publication, has put forth Israel's contentions regarding the exercise of its right of self-defense, and the elimination of what Israel termed the "illegal" blockade of Israeli shipping through the Suez Canal and the Gulf of Agaba.

Arab States

The propaganda of the Arab Information Center consists of press releases, a publication entitled "For the Record," a monthly review of progress in the Arab

countries known as "The Arab World," and numerous pamphlets dealing with the crisis in the Middle East. Attention is directed to the Arab position regarding the nationalization of the Suez Canal and Arab allegations regarding the motivation for the Anglo-French-Israeli military action in Egypt. Materials disseminated by the Palestine Arab Refugee Office are designed to support the cause of the Arab refugees.

Great Britain

While the British Information Services, through the media of printed matter, radio broadcasts, television and lectures, has touched upon almost all phases of life in the British Commonwealth, emphasis in 1956 was placed upon a presentation of the viewpoints within Britain regarding the nationalization of the Suez Canal, the Middle East conflict, and the Cyprus question.

A mimeographed sheet entitled "Summary of the British Weeklies" reflects a divided opinion in Great Britain with regard to Colonel Nasser's seizure of the Suez Canal. Materials dealing with the subsequent Anglo-French intervention in Egypt reflect anxiety with respect to the timing of the British action, the lack of information presented to President Eisenhower, and the possibility that the intervention might unite the Arab nations and bring about a full-scale war. A pamphlet entitled

"Damage to Port Said" was issued in refutation of certain allegations of British damage to that city. Continued British possession of the island of Cyprus is treated as being of paramount importance. Materials point up the British interest as stemming primarily from the strategic military value of that island as well as British fears that, should Cyprus be annexed to Greece, measures may be taken by Turkey to protect the Turkish Cypriot minority. Attention is directed to the activities of Cypriot terrorists, and the reasons for the deportation of Archbishop Makarios, as well as other disciplinary action taken by the British.

British materials dealt additionally with numerous other matters of current interest, such as the question of Malayan independence, the then forthcoming independence of the Gold Coast, the Polish and Hungarian uprisings, and Soviet strategy in the Middle East.

U.S.S.R.

Unlike most other foreign governments, the Soviet
Union does not maintain an official information office
in the United States. Printed political propaganda is
disseminated through Imported Publications and Products,
Inc. and the Four Continent Book Corporation, both of
which are registered as agents of the All-Union Soviet
Book Combine in Moscow, and consists of magazines,

pamphlets, brochures, and newspapers, in both the English and Russian languages. The more important publications in English are "New Times," a weekly magazine containing articles of current political interest; "News," a bi-monthly review of world events as seen from the Soviet standpoint; "International Affairs," a monthly journal of political analysis; "Voks," an illustrated monthly; and "Soviet Woman," a monthly magazine which describes itself as being devoted to social and political problems, literature, and art.

Additionally, propaganda materials take the form of small brochures, published by the Foreign Languages Publishing House in Moscow, which deal with various and widely divergent subjects, e.g., "Equality of Women in the Economic Sphere," and "New Method of Soil and Crop Conservation."

The first monthly issue of the magazine "USSR" appeared in August, 1956. It is published by the Soviet Embassy in Washington under a reciprocal agreement which provides for the distribution of "USSR" in the United States and the magazine "Amerika" in the Soviet Union.

"USSR" can be purchased either at newsstands or by subscription. It attempts to give a kaleidoscopic view of the national life of the Soviet people, i.e., the Soviet people at home, at work, and at play, the cities they live in, the schools their children attend, the

movie stars they write fan letters to, the athletes they talk about. Young people are pictured as playing a significant part in the life of the nation. A recurring theme is the welcome accorded in Russia to foreign, especially American, visitors, with pictures of American tourists enjoying the sights of Moscow and other Soviet cities appearing in almost every issue.

China

The Chinese News Service, an information agency of the Nationalist Government of China, is the principal organization through which this government disseminates information to persons within the United States. This information takes the form of news from China and digests of opinion appearing in the American press. Views are set forth regarding the economy of China, opposition to the admission of Communist China to the United Nations, conditions in Communist China, the Geneva conferences, embargo on trade with Communist China, and the breaking of diplomatic relations with Egypt over its recognition of Communist China.

<u>India</u>

The Embassy of India and the Government of India
Information Services are the principal sources of this
nation's political propaganda. Press releases, bulletins,

and periodicals were disseminated, which dealt with such questions as India's dispute with Portugal over Goa, its dispute with Pakistan over Kashmir, and the Suez Canal crisis. Coverage was given to the visit of Prime Minister Nehru to the United States. Other matters covered included the economic development and trade relations of India and matters relating to the peaceful uses of atomic energy.

Indonesia

Materials concerning the economic progress and trade relations of Indonesia were disseminated by the Embassy of that nation. Considerable publicity was given to the visit of President Sukarno to the United States.

Republic of Korea

The Korean Affairs Institute and Korean Pacific

Press publish a number of bulletins and a publication

entitled "Korean Survey," which deal with matters such

as the question of unification, elections in Korea and

its economic development.

Latin America

Much of the material disseminated deals with the promotion of tourist traffic to, and the economic development and trade relations of the Latin American

countries. Another matter covered has been treatment by Cuba and the Dominican Republic of the United States' allotment of sugar quotas. The Information Center of the Dominican Republic has issued considerable material concerning that nation's views regarding the disappearance of Professor Jesus de Galindez. Political unrest in Cuba has led to the issuance of propaganda by a number of Cuban exiles in this country, attempting to enlist the support of the United States for their cause.

Greece

Large quantities of materials have been forwarded for further dissemination to sympathetic persons in the United States by groups in Greece which are interested in advancing the cause of "Enosis," or the unification of Cyprus with Greece. This material alleges acts of terrorism and brutality by the British upon the people of Cyprus, attacks the British for the exile of Arch-bishop Makarios, advances the position that the Cypriot people are of Greek descent, and attempts to win popular support for the removal of British control of Cyprus, and the union of that island with Greece.

LEGISLATION AND RULES

The amendment to the Foreign Agents Registration

Act provided by Section 20(a) of the Internal Security

Act of 1950 was repealed by the Act of August 1, 1956, c. 849, 70 Stat. 899, 50 U.S.C., Sections 851-857.

This statute requires the registration of persons who have knowledge of or have received assignment or training in the espionage, counterespionage, or sabotage service or tactics of a foreign government or foreign political party, irrespective of a technical agency status or relationship.

On December 13, 1956, pursuant to the authority conferred by Section 10 of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. I issued an order adopting amendatory rules and regulations governing the administration of the Act. One new rule states that a person outside of the United States who uses the mails or an instrumentality of interstate or foreign commerce to circulate political propaganda to addressees who have not ordered such material, shall be regarded as acting within the United States and as subject to the registration and filing provisions of the Act. Other new rules require that registrants report the names and addresses of persons who contribute funds to the registrant in the interest of a foreign principal, and the amount of funds or value of things contributed by such persons, and that registrants report the amount of funds collected in the United States which are transmitted to a foreign principal, in addition to the manner and time of such transmission of funds or thing of value. Another rule provides for the filing of a short-form registration statement by officers, partners, and other persons rendering assistance to a registrant which filed a statement in the name of a partnership, corporation, or other combination of individuals.

A new pamphlet containing a reprint of the Act and the revised rules and regulations promulgated there-under has been made available for distribution upon request.

ENFORCEMENT

While to a large extent voluntary compliance with the disclosure provisions of the Act by persons and organizations subject thereto was obtained, it was found necessary in 1956 to bring one prosecution charging wilful violation of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. This proceeding was brought against the Rumanian—American Publishing Association of Detroit, Michigan, and its officers, and it is charged therein that the organization unlawfully and wilfully acted as an agent for the Government of the People's Republic of Rumania without having filed the registration statement required by the Act. Its officers are charged with unlawfully and wilfully failing to cause the organization to execute

and file the necessary registration statement. Trial of this case is pending at this time. With few exceptions, compliance with the Act has been obtained through normal administrative procedures, as indicated by the large number of registrations at the end of the past year. The exceptional cases noted will be presented for prosecutive action where it is believed that sufficient evidence exists to secure convictions.

Registration does not imply recognition by the United States Government either of the <u>de jure</u> existence or legality of the foreign principal nor does registration indicate approval by the United States Government of the propaganda material disseminated by the registered agent.

The principal purpose of Congress in enacting the Foreign Agents Registration Act was to throw the spot-light of publicity upon the propaganda and other activities of those who are hired by foreign principals and the emphasis of the Department of Justice in its administration of the statute has been toward the achievement of this purpose. In performing its functions the Department has continued to rely upon its usual

sources of information, and upon the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
