At all times relevant to this Indictment:

- GARY P. MCPHERSON was a registered pharmacist practicing in Williamsburg, Kentucky.
- MCPHERSON worked as a pharmacist at KIM'S HOMETOWN
 PHARMACY, in Williamsburg, Kentucky, which is in the Eastern District of Kentucky.

COUNT 1

3. On or about May 10, 2018, in Whitley County, in the Eastern District of Kentucky,

GARY P. MCPHERSON

did, in, and using a means and facility of, interstate commerce, embezzle, steal, and by fraud and deception obtain, and knowingly take, carry away, and conceal a pre-retail medical product, to wit: **MCPHERSON**, who was employed by, and was an agent of, Kim's Hometown Pharmacy in Williamsburg, Kentucky, an organization in the supply

PENALTIES

supervised release of no more than 3 years.

PLUS: Restitution, if applicable.
