Broadcast radio has 5 times the operating expense that of the streaming industry. Yet Broadcast radio can afford to pay \$0.09 per play while on the other hand the Streaming industry only offers \$0.0003 - \$0.0008 per play (Spotify- Pandora). That's 3 to 8 ten-thousandths of a cent, not 9 cents. This is a gross inequity that needs to be addressed and put an end to.
