This information is being provided to you as a potential victim. Identified as a potential victim, please be advised of the following:

Those wishing to follow the case more closely through what is public record have the option to do so by signing up for a PACER account. PACER stands for "Public Access to Court Electronic Records", it is an electronic public access service that allows users to obtain case and docket information online from federal appellate, district, and bankruptcy courts.

For all public record case proceedings and court notes, individuals may sign up for a PACER account and follow the information on the website accordingly to sign up and look up the associated docket number at the top of this letter.

This is a service provided by the Federal Judiciary in keeping with its commitment to providing public access to court information via a centralized service. As a reminder, PACER is mandated by Congress and a program that is funded entirely through user fees set by the Judicial Conference. You may still log into the Victim Notification System (VNS) with your previously provided User ID and PIN to view notices generated. Through VNS you will continue to be provided with updated scheduling and event information as the case proceeds through the criminal justice system. You may obtain current information about this case on the VNS website at <https://www.notify.usdoj.gov> or from the VNS Call Center at 1-866-DOJ-4YOU (1-866-365-4968) (TDD/TTY: 1-866-228-4619) (International: 1-502-213-2767). In addition, you may use the Call Center or Internet to update your contact information and/or change your decision about participation in the notification program. The notices that are posted here are to ensure victims receive notice about their statutory rights and ongoing notifications as envisioned by the Crime Victims' Rights Act.
