DESHAWN TORRENCE, in or around August 2019 to October 2019, in the Eastern District of California, did, while acting under the color of law, willfully deprive B.G. of her fundamental right to bodily integrity, a right secured and protected by the Constitution and laws of the United States, when the defendant confined and carried away B.G. in a police vehicle against her will and, without her consent and without a legitimate law enforcement purpose, fondled her breasts and the outside of her vagina, and caused B.G. to touch his penis. The defendant's conduct included kidnapping.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 242.

COUNT TWO: [18 U.S.C. § 242 – Deprivation of Rights Under Color of Law Resulting in Bodily Injury and including Aggravated Sexual Abuse]
