# JUNE 28, 2018 NATIONAL HEALTH CARE FRAUD AND OPIOID TAKEDOWN BY THE NUMBERS

### • Largest ever Health Care Fraud (HCF) Takedown, in terms of:

- Fraud loss amount charged over \$2 billion
- Number of defendants charged **601**
- Number of medical professionals charged **165**
- Number of opioid defendants charged 162
- Number of federal districts involved **58**

### • Law Enforcement Coordination

- Number of federal districts/U.S. Attorney's Offices participating 58
- Number of federal prosecutors participating **151**
- Participating Medicare Fraud Strike Force (MFSF) Locations: 335 defendants charged in 10 districts

  - To date, including the figures from this Takedown, the Strike Force program will have prosecuted over **3,700** defendants in cases involving over **\$14** billion in losses to Medicare since 2007.

#### Categories of Defendants and Schemes

- **165** licensed medical professionals charged.
  - **76** Physicians
- 162 defendants charged in connection with the opioid epidemic.
  - 57 Medical Professionals, including 32 Physicians
- 132 defendants charged in cases involving pharmacy-related fraud.
  - 50 defendants are charged in connection with compounding pharmacy schemes in the 2018 Takedown. The fraudulent loss amount totals \$560 million.

## • <u>HHS-OIG Exclusion Notices</u>:

- Since the 2017 takedown, OIG has excluded over **2,700** individuals from participation in Medicare, Medicaid, and all other Federal health care programs (more than **580** of these exclusions were opioid-related).

### DEA Registration Suspensions and Revocations:

Since July 2017, DEA has issued **16** Immediate Suspension Orders, **74** Orders to Show Cause, and received **736** Surrenders for Cause for violations of the Controlled Substances Act.
