THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

### COUNT ONE [21 U.S.C. § 846]

That beginning on or about August of 2014, the exact date unknown to the Grand Jury, and continuing until on or about May of 2016, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

#### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, MICHELLE CHAVEZ.

#### JOSE LUIS BALDERAS,

#### JAVIER HERNANDEZ,

and others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate, and agree together and with one another to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance,

contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C), and in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

That on or about December 29, 2014, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

That on or about January 26, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

#### JOSE LUIS BALDERAS,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

### COUNT FOUR [21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C)]

That on or about February 5, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

## COUNT FIVE [21 U.S.C. § 841(a) (1), 841(b) (1) (C)]

That on or about February 20, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

## COUNT SIX [21 U.S.C. § 841(a) (1), 841(b) (1) (C)]

That on or about March 3, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

That on or about March 16, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

That on or about April 6, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

#### JOSE LUIS BALDERAS,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections

841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

That on or about May 8, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, AND JAVIER HERNANDEZ,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

That on or about May 21, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

#### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, AND JAVIER HERNANDEZ,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code,

Section 2.

#### [21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C)] [18 U.S.C. § 2]

That on or about June 9, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

#### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, AND MICHELLE CHAVEZ,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

#### COUNT TWELVE [21 U.S.C. § 841(a) (1), 841(b) (1) (C)]

That on or about August 7, 2015, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

# COUNT THIRTEEN [21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C)] [18 U.S.C. § 2]

That on or about January 5, 2016, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, AND MICHELLE CHAVEZ,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

# COUNT FOURTEEN [21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C)] [18 U.S.C. § 2]

That on or about March 4, 2016, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

#### JESUS ARMANDO CHAVEZ, AND MICHELLE CHAVEZ,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally aid and abet each other to possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which offense involved a quantity of cocaine, a Schedule II Controlled

Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
