Defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN ("KRAJEKIAN") was an 24 Arizona resident. KRAJEKIAN currently lives in Chandler, Arizona. 25 FEDERAL RESERVE NOTES 26 2. The United States Department of the Treasury, through the Bureau of

Engraving and Printing ("BEP"), develops and produces United States currency notes.

As its primary function, the BEP oversees the production of billions of dollars in Federal

Reserve Notes ("FRN"). The production of FRN involves highly-trained and skilled craftspeople, specialized equipment, and a combination of traditional, old-world printing techniques merged with sophisticated, cutting-edge technology.

- 3. The BEP produces genuine FRN through a combination of printing processes, which include offset, intaglio, and typographic printing.
 - a. <u>Offset Printing</u>: This involves the printing of background colors by high-speed, offset presses. These presses print security offset image designs onto currency paper.
 - b. <u>Intaglio Printing</u>: Some images are engraved onto the surface of a plate. Ink is applied to a plate so that it remains only in the engraved areas. Paper is then laid atop, and the two plates are pressed together under great pressure. As a result, the ink from the recessed areas is pulled onto the paper, creating a raised, finished image. Intaglio printing is used for the portraits, vignettes, scrollwork, numerals, and lettering, which are unique to each denomination.
 - c. <u>Typographic Printing</u>: This final process utilizes the letterpress printing process. This process adds two serial numbers, the black universal Federal Reserve seal, the green Department of the Treasury seal, and the corresponding Federal Reserve identification number to each FRN.
 - 4. The paper and ink used in the production of FRN is unique as well.
- 5. Each FRN contains a year or series printed on the actual bill. This year does not necessarily represent the year it was printed. The series designation changes only when significant changes are made to the note design.
- 6. The serial number ("SN") found on each FRN serves to uniquely identify each note within its denomination and series.
- 7. The Face Plate ("FP") number identifies the particular printing plate that was used to print the face side of a note. The Back Plate ("BP") number identifies the plate used for the backside of the note.

8. Genuine FRN are circulated through the Federal Reserve, which operates as the United States' Central Bank and serves to ensure that adequate amounts of currency are in circulation.

COUNTERFEIT CURRENCY

- 9. The United States Secret Service ("USSS") keeps track of counterfeit currency, rates the quality of each counterfeit bill, and classifies notes based on common characteristics.
- 10. Counterfeit notes that are produced utilizing any of the above-mentioned printing methods (intaglio, offset, or typographic) are referred to as circular notes ("Cnotes"). A permanent and unique number, beginning with a "C", is assigned to each counterfeit note. This number also associates that specific counterfeit note with any other note that shares common defects/characteristics, which include paper quality, ink used, printing plates, and printing methodology. Notes that are part of the same classification scheme are commonly referred to as variations.
- 11. When a new counterfeit note is discovered, a new number is created. This is used for tracking and identification purposes.

THE COUNTERFEIT SOUTHWEST NOTE

- 12. The USSS divides the United States into four regions: region 1 is the Northeast; region 2 is the Midwest; region 3 is the Southeast; and region 4 is the West coast, the Northwest, and the Southwest. Arizona is located in region 4.
- 13. Starting in 2003, and to the present day, region 4 has experienced an increased use and circulation of a high quality counterfeit \$100 bill. The note became so prolific that the USSS began to refer to this specific counterfeit bill as the "Southwest note."
- 14. There are several versions of the Southwest note, with the latest variation being introduced into the Phoenix-metropolitan area in 2014.
 - 15. The Southwest note is a sophisticated counterfeit product. It is produced

using much of the same printing technology the government uses in the production of a genuine FRN. In addition, the Treasury Seal and serial numbers on the Southwest note appear to have been computer generated. In order to mimic a genuine bill, the note is composed of two sheets of paper glued together that contain an embedded counterfeit security thread. The Southwest note also contains blue and red fibers, which imitate genuine security fibers but do not share the same characteristics as real fibers.

16. For years, defendant KRAJEKIAN, working with others, obtained, possessed, passed, and transferred high-quality counterfeit U.S. currency (consistent with the Southwest note) and circulated said counterfeit U.S. currency at commercial establishments around the U.S. in exchange for legitimate U.S. currency and other items of value.

17. On or about May 1, 2009, KRAJEKIAN passed \$100 counterfeit bills (Southwest notes) at the following retail establishments at the Mesa Fiesta Mall, 1445 W. Southern Ave, Mesa, Arizona:

He was stopped by law enforcement, and in his rental car was \$54,000 in counterfeit currency, composed of \$100 bills. The counterfeit bills were determined to be Southwest notes. KRAJEKIAN also had in his possession several \$10 gift cards, which were purchased in New Mexico, Texas, and Oklahoma.

COUNT ONE Conspiracy (18 U.S.C. § 371)

- 25. The factual allegations in paragraphs 1-24 of the Indictment are incorporated by reference and re-alleged as though fully set forth herein.
- 26. Beginning at a time unknown to the Grand Jury, but at least as early as on or about 2003, to the present, in the District of Arizona and elsewhere, defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN, along with others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did knowingly and willfully agree and conspire with each other to commit one or more of the following offenses against the United States:
 - a. Title 18, United States Code, Section 471, Obligations or Securities of the United States;
 - b. Title 18, United States Code, Section 472, Uttering Counterfeit Obligations or Securities; and
 - c. Title 18, United States Code, Section 473, Dealing in Counterfeit

Obligations or Securities.

OBJECTS OF THE CONSPIRACY

- 27. The objects of the conspiracy were:
 - a. To produce and/or obtain high quality counterfeit \$100 bills;
 - b. To circulate and distribute counterfeit currency into legitimate commercial businesses;
 - c. To purchase inexpensive items or gift cards from merchants and pay for these nominal commercial items with counterfeit \$100; and
 - d. To obtain and accumulate large amounts of genuine currency, and other things of value, in exchange for the counterfeit \$100 bills being circulated and passed at these commercial businesses.

MANNER AND MEANS OF THE CONSPIRACY AND SCHEME TO DEFRAUD

28. The manner and means of the conspiracy are described in paragraphs 1-27 above, incorporated by reference and re-alleged as though fully set forth herein.

OVERT ACTS

29. In furtherance of the conspiracy, and to achieve the objects of the conspiracy, defendant, and others known and unknown, committed or caused to be committed various overt acts in the District of Arizona and elsewhere. The following overt acts, among others, were committed:

Conspiracy to Launder Monetary Instruments 18 U.S.C. § 1956(h)

- 30. The factual allegations in paragraphs 1-29 and 33 of the Indictment are incorporated by reference and re-alleged as though fully set forth herein.
- 31. Beginning at a time unknown to the Grand Jury, but at least as early as on or about 2003, to the present, in the District of Arizona and elsewhere, defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN, along with others, known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did knowingly conspire, and agree to commit a money laundering offense against the United States, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956, to wit: to knowingly conduct and attempt to conduct a financial transaction affecting interstate and foreign commerce, which involved the proceeds of a specified unlawful activity, that is violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 471 (Obligations or Securities of the United States); Title 18, United States Code, Section 472 (Uttering Counterfeit Obligations or Securities); and Title 18, United States Code, Section 473 (Dealing in Counterfeit Obligations or Securities), with the intent to promote the carrying on of said specified unlawful activity, that is counterfeiting activities, and that while conducting and

attempting to conduct such financial transactions, defendant and others knew that the property involved in the financial transactions represented the proceeds of some form of unlawful activity as described herein.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956(h).

COUNTS THREE - TWENTY-THREE Uttering Counterfeit Obligations or Securities 18 U.S.C. § 472

- 32. The factual allegations in paragraphs 1-31 of the Indictment are incorporated by reference and re-alleged as though fully set forth herein.
- 33. On or about the dates listed below, in the District of Arizona and elsewhere, defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN, along with others both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, with intent to defraud, did pass, utter, and attempt to pass and utter a falsely made, forged, and counterfeited obligation of the United States, that is, a Federal Reserve Note in the denomination of one hundred dollars, with a corresponding identifier, which he and others then knew to be falsely made, forged and counterfeited, as set forth in the chart below, each such instance being a separate count of this Indictment:

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

- 34. The factual allegations in paragraphs 1 through 33 of the Indictment are incorporated by reference and re-alleged as though set forth fully herein.
- 35. Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Sections 981(a)(1)(C) and 982(a)(2)(B), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461, and as a result of committing one or more of the offenses in Counts 1 23 of this Indictment, defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN shall forfeit to the United States, all property, real and personal, that constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to the commission of the offenses, including but not limited to the aggregate sum of \$2.5 million, in that the aggregate sum is the proceeds of the specified unlawful acts, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1956(c)(7)(A) and 1961(1), to wit: Title 18, United States Code, Section 472 (Uttering Counterfeit Obligations and Securities).
- 36. Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(1), and as a result of committing the money laundering offense charged in Count 2 of this Indictment, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956(h), defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN shall forfeit to the United States:
 - a. All right, title and interest in any and all property, real and personal, involved in the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956(h), if convicted, and all property traceable to such property, including the following: 1) all money or other property that was the subject of each transaction, transportation,

transmission, or transfer in violation of Section 1956(h); 2) all commissions, fees, and other property constituting proceeds obtained as a result of this violation; and 3) all property used in any manner to commit or facilitate the commission of this offense.

- b. A sum of money equal to the total amount of money involved in the Section 1956(h) offense, if convicted.
- 37. Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 492, and as a result of committing one or more of the offenses in Counts 1, 3 23 of this Indictment, defendant GARBIS ARAM KRAJEKIAN shall forfeit to the United States all articles, devices, and other things made, possessed or used or intended to be used in violation of Title 18, Untied States Code, Section 472.
- 38. Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(b), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461, defendant shall forfeit substitute property, up to the value of the amount described above, if by any act or omission of defendant, the property described above, or any portion thereof, cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence; has been transferred, sold to or deposited with a third party; has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court; has been substantially diminished in value; or has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty.
