receiver to enfo	orce the lien. The sale of the	property by a local real estate broke
acting as a Rec	eiver is likely to yield a higher sale pri	ice and larger net proceeds than would an
auction sale by	the United States Marshal pursuant to	26 U.S.C. § 2001.
