1. The United States' Complaint in this action sought to re	duce federal tax liabilities of
to a money judgment, to foreclose the associate	ted federal tax liens against the
property, and to have that property sold for	r application of an appropriate
portion of the net sale proceeds to the federal tax liabilities of	
2. By Order dated this Court entered a n	money judgment in favor of
the United States and against for unpaid taxes for	in
the total amount of \$plus interest and other addi	tions from the dates of

assessment. By that same order, this Court also granted the United States' request for foreclosure

of its tax liens on the	property.	By a separate co	ntemporaneous motion the
United States seeks the appointment	of a Receiver t	to take custody of	, and to arrange for the sale
of the propert	y.		
4. The defendant continues to	o occupy the _		property. His continuing
occupancy is likely to substantially in	mpede the Rec	eiver's efforts to	market and arrange for the
sale of the prop	perty. This Co	urt, under the autl	nority of 26 U.S.C. § 7402
(a), has the power to enter such order	rs "as may be n	necessary or appro	opriate for the enforcement
of the internal revenue laws." In ord	er for the Rece	iver's marketing	and arrangements for the
sale of the property	to proceed, thi	s Court should or	der the defendant,
and all other per	sons acting wi	th, or on his beha	lf, or residing thereon, to
vacate and depart from the	pr	operty on or before	re 12:00 o'clock noon on
Further, the	nis Court shoul	d authorize and d	irect the United States
Marshal to enforce that Order at any	time he deems	appropriate after	12:00 o'clock noon on
by evicting ar	y unauthorized	d persons from all	locations on the
property, incl	uding but not l	imited to the struc	ctures, vehicles, and
grounds, and by using force as necess	sary to accomp	olish that mission.	In addition, this Court
should state in its order that any failu	re to vacate an	d depart from the	3
property, or any attempt to reenter or	nto the property	y, could subject th	nat person to being found in
contempt of this Court, and that such	contempt cou	ld be punishable	by a fine, incarceration, or
both. Finally, that order should dire	ct the U.S. Ma	arshals Service to	provide notice of the order
to by hand deliv	ery or by leavi	ng it in a promine	ent location at the building at
the property.
