so shipped or transported by any means, including by computer, if the producing of the visual depiction involved the use of a minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct and such visual depiction is of such conduct (child pornography). A visual depiction involved in the offense involved a prepubescent minor or a minor who had not attained 12 years of age. FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

The Grand Jury realleges and incorporates the allegations of Counts 1-11 of this Indictment, which are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.

Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Sections 981 and 2253, Title 21 United States Code, Section 853, Title 26, United States Code, Section 5872, and Title 28, United

America all right, title, and interest in any visual depiction, or any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation of statute, and any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offense, and any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offenses or any property traceable to such property, including by not limited to, an external hard drive and laptop computer seized by law enforcement on April 10, 2024.

States Code, Section 2461(c), and upon conviction of one or more of the offenses alleged

Pursuant to Title 26, United States Code, Section 5872, and upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 11 of this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America all right, title, and interest in (a) any property constituting, or derived from, any proceeds the persons obtained, directly or indirectly, as the result of the offense, and (b) any property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of such offense.

If any forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (1) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence,
- (2) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party,
- (3) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court,
- (4) has been substantially diminished in value, or
- (5) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

it is the intent of the United States to seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the above-described forfeitable property, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. Section 853(p).
