The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

On or about July 5, 2023, within the District of Columbia, Jaime Macedo, while armed with a firearm, did attempt, by force and violence, against resistance and by putting in fear, to steal and take personal property, from the person and from the immediate actual possession of Maxwell Emerson. (Attempt To Commit Robbery While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2801, 2802, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about July 5, 2023, within the District of Columbia, Jaime Macedo did possess a firearm while committing the crime of Attempt to Commit Robbery While Armed as set forth in the First Count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

Jaime Macedo, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, in perpetrating and attempting to perpetrate the crime of robbery, as set forth in the First count of this indictment, killed Maxwell Emerson by shooting him with a firearm on or about July 5, 2023, thereby causing injuries from which Maxwell Emerson died on or about July 5, 2023. (First Degree Murder While Armed - Felony Murder, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about July 5, 2023, within the District of Columbia, Jaime Macedo did possess a firearm while committing the crime of First Degree Murder While Armed - Felony Murder as set forth in the Third Count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

FIFTH COUNT:

On or about July 5, 2023, within the District of Columbia, Jaime Macedo, knowing he had previously been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, owned, kept, and had within his possession and control, a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of a Firearm (Prior Conviction), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4503 (a)(1) (2001 ed.))
