

The United States charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about August 14, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, MANUEL LIRA-RIVERA, in a matter within the jurisdiction of the Social Security Administration, for the purpose of obtaining something of value and for other purposes, to wit: the use of a fraudulently obtained Social Security Number in an employment application, knowingly and with intent to deceive, did falsely represent that Social Security Number XXX-XX-6757 was



assigned to him by the Commissioner of Social Security when, in fact, as defendant well knew, said Social Security Number had not been assigned to him by the Commissioner of Social Security.
